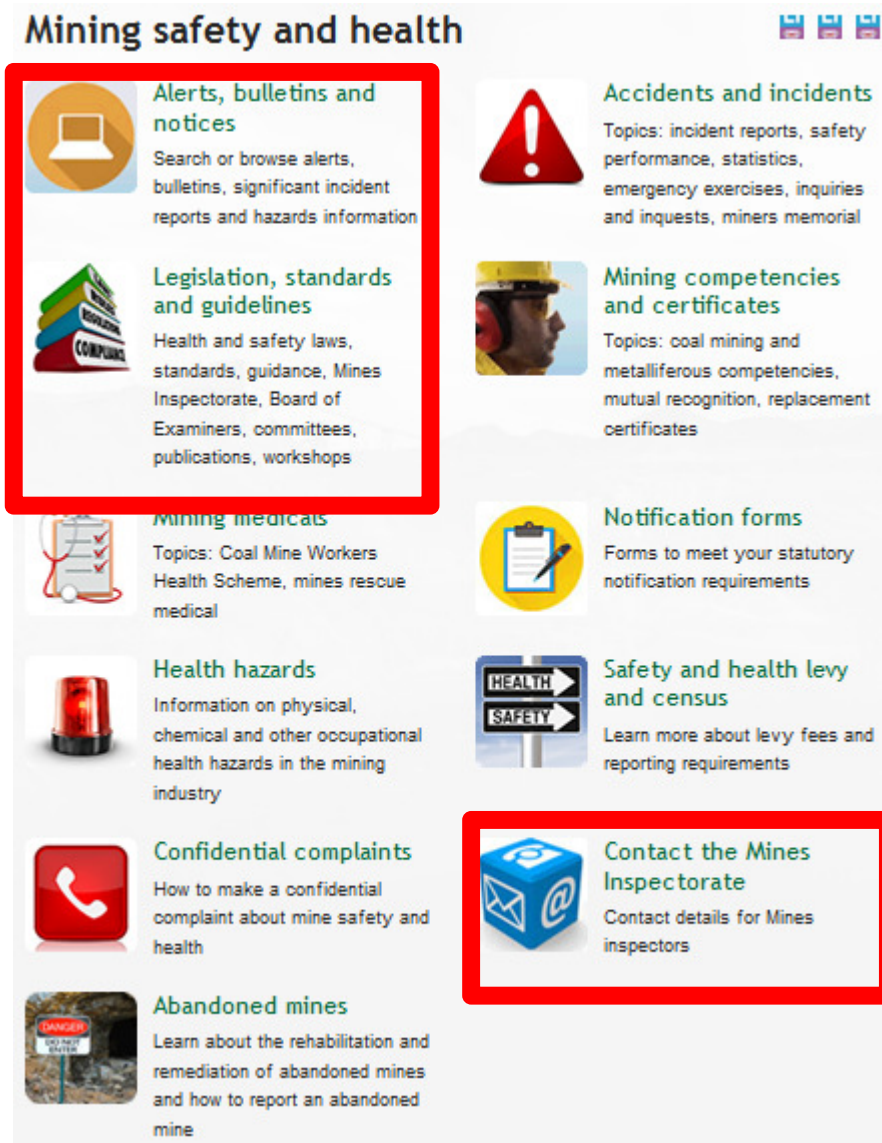
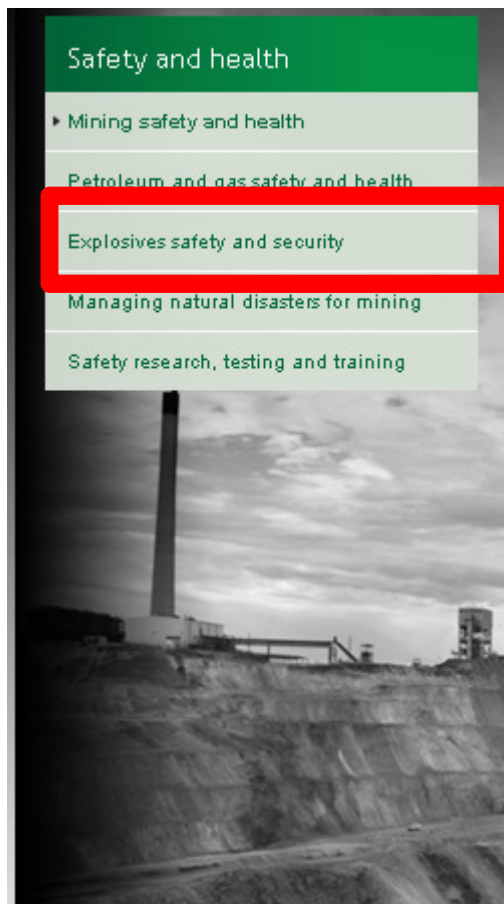

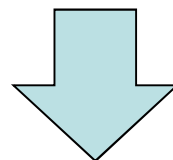

As a mining or quarry operator in Queensland, you must comply with mine safety and health legislation, including:
