Supporting information for Application for an associated water licence

Purpose of the form

The 'Application for an associated water licence' (the form) is an approved form under the *Water Act 2000* (Water Act). Under the Water Act, the chief executive may grant the holder of a mining lease, or mineral development licence, an associated water licence for taking of, or interfering with associated water in a regulated underground water area.

The form is used where the tenure holder wishes to take or interfere with water from an aquifer/s within a regulated underground water area under any land during the course of, or resulting from, carrying out an authorised activity for the tenure (associated water). Before commencing any activity which results in water being taken or interfered, the entity must make prior application by completing and lodging the form.

Unless otherwise indicated, all parts of the form should be completed. The department may require the applicant to give additional information and will be contacted if this is the case.

Part A Applicant Details

For the purpose of this application, the 'applicant' refers to the corporation(s) applying for an associated water licence. To be eligible to apply, the applicant must be the holder, or will be the holder, of the mining lease/s and/or mineral development licence/s to which associated water is to be taken.

Applicant details must be completed as follows:

Corporation

For a corporation, write the complete name of the incorporated body and the Australian Company Number (ACN).

For example: PAUL JOHN SMITH PTY LTD

For incorporated associations, use the authorising officer's name.

This part is used to specify what water is to be taken, and to state the location from which water is to be taken or or interfered with.

The applicant must identify the mining lease/s or mining development licence/s overlying the aquifer/s where underground water is to be taken or interfered with.

Part C Proposed tenure activity that will result in the take or interference with underground water

This part is used to indicate to what extent the planned activity would result in taking or interfering with underground water, and to generally assess the impact of the proposal in accordance with the Water Act. For example, dewatering using a borefield to lower the aquifer below the bottom of the pit; pumping from a sump into the pit; evaporation from the working face and/or pool within the final void.

Part D Information

The application must include sufficient information to address the criteria in section 1250E(c) to (i) of the *Water Act 2000*. These are:

- any existing water entitlements and authorities to take or interfere with water
- any environmental assessments carried out in relation to the mining tenure, including
 - any conditions imposed on the mining tenure or on the environmental authority granted in relation to the mining tenure; and
 - any report prepared by the Co-ordinator-General under the *State Development and Public Works Organisation Act 1971*, section 34D evaluating the EIS prepared in relation to the mining tenure
- any information about the effects of taking, or interfering with, water on the natural ecosystem
- any information about the effects of taking or interfering with, water on the physical integrity of watercourses, lakes, springs and aquifers
- strategies for the management of impacts on underground water, including the impacts of dewatering
- strategies and policies for the relevant coastal zone
- records of public interest

Part E Declaration

Parties to the application listed in Part B, must complete and sign the declaration. This means that all the holders should sign where the mining leases or mining development licences described in Part C are held by a number of holders.

All persons signing on behalf of a corporation must sign before a witness and provide their Australian Company Number (ACN).

Materials submitted in support of this application are part of the application and can be copied and made available to the public as required under section 112(4)(b) of the Water Act. By signing the declaration, all parties provide consent for any supplied information considered to be commercial-in-confidence or copyright to be copied and made available only for the purposes of the licence application, including notification to and consultation with the public and other relevant government agencies.

Use of this information (privacy statement)

The information being collected in this form will be used by this department for the purpose of processing your application to take associated underground water under the authority of Chapter 9, Division 2 of the Water Act. This application will be publicly viewable in the period in which people may make submissions. The instrument of the water authority will be placed on a publicly searchable register under section 1009 of the Water Act. If a submitter chooses to apply for an internal review of the department's decision on this application, your name and address will be provided to them, so that they may provide you with notice of their application for internal review.

Your personal details will be accessed only by authorised officers within this department and will not be disclosed to any other third party without your consent except where required by law. The information collected will be retained as required by the *Public Records Act 2002* and may be stored in a departmental database. Information on the department's privacy commitment can be found on the department's website at www.dnrm.qld.gov.au.

Fees and charges

The prescribed fee payable at the time of application is changed each year with the consumer price index (CPI) and takes effect from 1 July each year. Prior to submitting an application immediately following 1 July contact your nearest departmental office to obtain details of the current fees.
