The holder of an allocation notice must submit to the chief executive a monthly return within seven days after the end of each month, listing all quarry material removed by the holder from a watercourse or lake within that month. This return must be submitted even if no quarry material was taken. Where state quarry material is removed, payment of royalty must be made.

Certificate of royalty exemption for removal of State quarry material

Water Act 2000

Purpose of the Form

Evidence that quarry material removed or supplied was for a statutory body, local government or department in accordance with section 135 of the Water Regulation 2016.

In order to claim an exemption from the payment of the full applicable royalty the allocation notice holder must submit this certificate when lodging their QMAN monthly return.

The certificate will need to be signed by a representative of the local government or statutory body or a delegate of the chief executive of the department.
