- Should the land become transferable land, the Department will consult with all Aboriginal people particularly concerned with the land[#], not just those persons that lodged the EOI. Consultation will determine a grantee to hold the land, as trustee for the benefit of Aboriginal people.
- A grantee can only be an existing Aboriginal land trust established under the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* or a corporation established under the *Corporations (Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander) Act 2006*.
- Information you provide will only be used by the Department for the purposes of the *Aboriginal Land Act 1991* or *Land Act 1994*.
- Information you provide might be able to be searched under the *Right to Information Act 2009*.
- This form does not represent the lodgement of a native title claim under the *Native Title Act 1993*.
